Basking on the front porch, in the warm sun, this snoozing feline tempts us to join in on a nap. If you ever wanted to learn how to capture the effect of warm, golden tones and cool shadows, this is the project for you. You will learn to make color choices to mimic the bright, direct afternoon light; the relationship of warm and cool colors; how to make luminous shadows; the importance of reflected light; and, of course, how to create realistic fur.
